The Eagle and Maximilian Stamps of Mexico.

Apart from the historical associations of this period and varieties in the stamps themselves, such as plates, paper, &c., which usually interest specialists, there has been for many years past a certain amount of interest taken in the above in consequence of the system of overprinting. It has been generally assumed that a new and more elaborate method of accounting came into force when the Eagle series was first issued, but as a matter of fact there is very little modification in the system from what was laid down in the regulations of July 15th, 1856, as will be seen from the following extracts :—

ART. 7.—The Cashier will transfer the debit of these stamps to the accounts office with a detailed invoice of their value, which shall bear its corresponding correlative numbering.

ART. 10.—These accounts (i.e. from the principal post offices) shall be sent in each month in book form with their respective vouchers, amongst which shall be included the invoices of which Art. 7 treats.

ART. 11.—The subordinate offices shall render their accounts to the principal offices to which they are attached.

ART. 15.—To avoid fraud in consequence of robbery or loss of stamps in transit there will be sent others (i.e. stamps or seals) privately to the postmaster, so that immediately they receive the stamps they shall overprint each one before proceeding to sell same, so that should any stamps be offered for sale in any place without this requisite they shall be treated as of no value or use.

It will be seen from this that provision was made for the consecutive numbering of the invoices and for the overprinting of the names of districts, and the account books relating to these early periods differ very little from those of the Maximilian period.

A photograph of the original circular of instructions is enclosed, and the following is a translation of same :—

CIRCULAR No. 13.

ADMINISTRACION GENERAL DE CORREOS.

MEXICO, *June 20th*, 1864.

Experience showing the necessity there is for the existence of effective rules to put an end to the abuses to which the circulation of postage stamps gives place when these are intercepted or abstracted from the offices by violence, through *force majeure*, in order to prevent the evils which result from such acts or others similar, it is ordered as a general rule that in future, and prior to the despatch from this principal administration to the chief offices of the department of the supplies of stamps for public correspondence, which they request or which are sent them for their office and for their branches, they should bear another black impression which shall show on each one of the stamps the progressive number of the invoice with which they are sent, and the year in which despatched, similar to the impression which they have to indicate their validity when they enter into circulation, and which on no account should be omitted.

The same offices will act similarly on supplying their branches with the stock they require, with the difference that the black seal which they are to use will only show the correlative number, not a private number, which corresponds with the sending invoice which they make of said stamps to each one of their branches. For this purpose they should have a double set only of numbers from one to zero in loose pieces, so that by means of a screw there may be fastened into the frame the numbers with which it is intended to make the corresponding impression, which shall be, as before mentioned, the same as that of the sending invoice.

In the towns in which there is no engraver, or where the making of the stamp spoken of is difficult, the chief postmasters should send in advance to the general post office the \$4 cost, so that the stamp may be sent to each one requiring it.

In such manner, and in the event that the robbery or loss of stamps arises from those which are sent directly from the general to any of the principal post offices, this office having satisfied itself of the fact, will proceed immediately and by the first post to advise the same offices by means of a circular, which they in turn will send to their branches, so that being notified of what has occurred, they will not be taken unawares, and will refuse to honour such stamps, which by this act have been eliminated from the legal nucleus of their origin, cease to have any value, and consequently are cancelled for the object for which they were intended.

The principal postmasters will act in the same manner in regard to their branches, and first of all with this general office, whenever any robbery or loss of stamps is advised on being remitted to any of the offices under their control for their sale. In such case the advice in which such occurrence is notified should further contain a precise statement of the two numbers of the invoices marked on the stamps, that is to say the one which was placed upon them on being remitted from the general post office, and the other which

each one bears from the principal office which sent them, sending also to the other principal offices the same circular for their information each time that such an occurrence takes place, in a similar way to what has been prescribed in the first case mentioned.

In any event in which stolen stamps appear in circulation, all the postmasters are under the obligation of proceeding under the most strict responsibility in conformity with what is prescribed in Art. 16 of the rules of the 15th July, 1856, communicating the fact at once to this general post office, as also the result of the judicial investigation which is made in the matter.

As the post offices are the only depositories which legally exist for the issue of stamps, in future, and whenever any robbery or loss of the same has taken place in the course of being sent to their destination, each office will notify the public of what has occurred, so that being aware of the uselessness of the stolen stamps, they may not be taken unawares if such are acquired without examination, thus making them accomplices in the crime which such acts amount to.

The same procedure must be adopted when the robbery or loss occurs directly from some office of the service. For this reason, and as a means of precaution, the principal postmasters should take care not to mark all the stock of stamps they possess, but only such as are required for daily use, and in their turn those which they have to send to provide for the necessities of their branches. Further, as it may happen that some private person locally possesses stamps similar to those stolen because he has purchased them with all necessary requisites from the office from which they were stolen, to avoid the change of stamps, which by this act it would be necessary to make, and the holder of same having appeared in accordance with the corresponding notice, the postmaster responsible being assured of their legal origin by the information which he has, in accordance with the rule contained in the first paragraph of Circular No. 10 of this year, will proceed to repeat in the centre of each one of the stamps the countersign which certifies them, with which necessary mark, which can only be repeated by the office from which they were issued, and having previously given advice of what has happened to the general post office, the stamps may be available for their purpose, thus entering into circulation.

This new procedure will take effect in full on the part of the principal post offices as soon as they are provided with the stamp spoken of, and as soon as this has been done they will take care to communicate at once with the general post office, so that being advised of same they may work in consort with the offices that possess them in those cases which occur, and which are provided for in the present circular of which I hand you copies, so that you may distribute same amongst your branches, taking care to advise me of their receipt.

It will be seen that the most notable difference is the overprinting of the invoice number and date on the stamps themselves in addition to the name of the district in which the stamps were sold.

The Eagle stamps may be divided into five periods :—

1. With name of district only.
2. With name of district and in addition invoice number and year in large figures.
3. With name of district and in addition invoice number and year (1864) in small figures.
4. Similar but date (1865).
5. Similar but date (1866).

At the very commencement a few stamps were used without overprint either of district, number or date.

As far as is known stamps in this condition are confined to the districts of Lagos, Morelia, S.L. Potosi, Tampico, Toluca and Zacatecas.

Stamps used from Maravatio may also be found in this condition, but as the sales in May and June, 1864, were made from a few stamps borrowed from Morelia, it seems probable that those without overprint were from the borrowed stock and probably came from invoices dated on first three days of despatch, viz., May 8th to 10th. The first supply to Mexico was sent May 14th.

After this, with the exception of Colima, which name is never, and Campeche which only rarely, is overprinted, it is very exceptional to find the district overprint omitted.

It will be seen from the circular that the same system of consecutively numbering invoices when sending from Head Office to Principal Offices was ordered to be adopted when sending remittances from these principal offices to their subordinates.

Great variation in the interpretation of these instructions apparently prevailed. It is not necessary here to go into details, as the lists which follow explain, by means of notes, the principal variations. Perhaps the most notable instance of carrying out the instructions under this head is that where Chalco carefully shows the number and date of subconsignments on stamps of the earliest period which bore no invoice number when sent from the Head Office. Examples of these are exceedingly scarce.

In certain districts subordinate towns of importance were treated as sub-principals, and had in turn other minor offices reporting to and receiving their supplies

from them. There is, therefore, the possibility of finding two different sub-consignment numbers on a stamp. Thus in the Querétaro district Celaya, S. Juan del Rio and S. Miguel Allende each had subordinate offices reporting to them whose sales were included in their reports to Querétaro, and in my collection there is a stamp, No. 129, 1864, with two sub-consignment numbers, Nos. 34 and 8. The cancellation is not sufficiently clear to determine exactly, but this consignment was probably sent to Celaya and the number 8 impressed when sending to Chamacuero.

In some districts when supplies were sent to important sub-principals the name of the principal was not overprinted, but the name of the sub-principal is impressed instead. Thus we find in the district of GUADALAJARA, Cocula, Colima, Tepic and Zapotlan, in CHIHUAHUA, Parral, in HERMOSILLO, Guaymas, in ZACATECAS, Aguascal(ien)tes in each case without the name of the principal.

During the whole period, May 8th, 1864, to April 22nd, 1867, there was much internal trouble in various parts of Mexico, with the result that frequent changes were made whereby places which were inaccessible for the time being from their regular principal offices came temporarily under the control of some other offices, as for instance, Huajuapam, which normally reported to Puebla but on other occasions to Oaxaca. In 1865, for instance, this office reported to Puebla in January and February. In May the stock of stamps in hand was returned to Puebla and sent to Mexico. Huajuapam then reported to Oaxaca, but in October once more was placed under control of Puebla.

The complete official records in regard to these changes have not so far been found, but in the appendix giving the names of the principal offices with their subordinates many cross-references are shown which it is hoped will help collectors in clearing up, at any rate, a certain number of troublesome queries.

Owing to the disturbed state of the roads, certain consignments failed to reach their destination, and from official circulars notifying postmasters of such cases, the following have been noted :—

* The circular says 29 and 17, which cannot be, as 29 is TULA. The date also should be September 14th, on which day sub-consignment 17 was despatched.

In all probability there may be others which should be added to the foregoing list. For instance, on the Zacatecas accounts against invoice 204—1865 there is a note that the stamps were stolen in transit and subsequently credited.

I have seen no specimens of this number nor of Nos. 202 and 203 of 1865, which were despatched on same day.

On the other hand I have specimens of Nos. 204 and 244 of 1864, 8 and 112 of 1865, 35, 48, and 117 of 1866.

Philatelists generally, and Mexican specialists in particular, are much indebted to the Mexican Government for their past assistance and co-operation in affording me the opportunity of inspecting Post Office Archives in any part of Mexico, for lending me large numbers of original documents and accounts, and for specially extracting a considerable amount of information from their books.

Mr. W. T. Wilson for many years has kept notes of stamps passing through his hands in the many important collections he has either acquired or had the opportunity of inspecting, and these notes have been freely used in the present work.

Many other prominent Philatelists have co-operated either by sending notes or lending stamps to me for inspection, and in the lists which follow the sources of information are indicated as follows :—

It seems unlikely, however, that any number prior to 19, 1865, was shown on the stamps.

(77) Durango always shows the year in full, as well as the sub-consignment number.

(78) Error of number. See Note 44.

(79) Guadalajara appears to have misunderstood the instructions in Circular 13, and to have continued the consecutive numbering from 1864 into 1865, as numbers 1 to 11 of 1865 have never been traced. Scott, however, records 12-1864 (Tepic) on 243, 2R, and the authors have seen what appears to be 13-1864 on 167 8R (C), and on 207 1R (C), but the number, being obscured by heavy postmark, is not sufficiently clear to record. Further information as to this period is required.

(80) From this number the year is omitted. 15 exists, both with and without, but the year is only inserted when overprinted on stamps bearing a principal invoice number of 1864.

(81) In this case and others similarly when two names are shown the second indicates the cancellation of the place from where the stamp was used. Such place is usually under the control of the first-named.

(82) Cancelled in MS. with "firma" only. Probably used from Sayula. May also be found with MS. overprint Zapotlan, and used from that town (2R H2).

(83) With MS. cancellation. Probably Santiago Ixcuintla.

(84) MS. cancellation. Probably Etzatlan.

(85) Zapotlan el Grande was named Ciudad Guzman by decree of 19th April, 1856. It was a "sub-principal" to Guadalajara, and had apparently eleven subordinate offices reporting to it.

(86) No. 176-1864 may be found with 39 (2R C). This is probably 63 with figures misplaced.

(87) May be found with Silao cancellation, 1R (C), but this merely shows the letter was posted there.

(88) Also on "01" 2R (C). See Note 34.

(89) Don José Marcó del Pont records this number with part of a cancellation reading PIE. There is practically no doubt this would be as shown above, as PIEDRAGORDA was a branch office reporting to Leon.

(90) Jalapa, like Cordova (see Note 73), evidently misunderstood the instructions in Circular 13. We find, for instance:—

Perote No. 14, August; S. Juan de los Llanos No. 14, November; Teziutlan No. 15, August; Zacapoaxtla No. 15, November.

Unlike Cordova, Jalapa always showed the year. In 1865 the year precedes the consignment number. In 1866 it follows.

(91) There is a note in the accounts that these stamps were stolen from the mail sack, but some, at any rate, were used, 2R on 100 (C).

(92) Altotonga was probably a branch office reporting to Perote, but failing complete official accounts, stamps postmarked Altotonga are included here, although there is no evidence to show that supplies were sent direct to this place from Jalapa.

(93) Don José Marcó del Pont says this is evidently an error. It appears to be perfectly correct, however, as no eight real stamps were sent to Jalapa in 1865 after invoice 42 and 58 of these remained on hand on 31st December, 1865.

(94) Lagos appears to have continued numbering consecutively from 1864 into 1865. Consignment No. 11 was sent out on January 3rd, and No. 12 on January 12th. No. 1 is shown, without date, as Encarnacion, and from the position of the entry on the account it would appear to have been sent about end of March or early in April. No explanation can be given as to why No. 1 was repeated either for Encarnacion or S. Juan. The date of despatch of the latter is October 26th. Most of the accounts for subordinate offices are missing after April, 1865, to end of that year. It is extremely improbable that sub-consignment numbers were shown on the stamps for 1864, 1865, and the early part of 1866. The only number known is 21 (in MS.) on 39-1866, 2R (C). The numbers queried for 1866 are probably correct, as the dates of despatch confirm, but the numbers were not inserted on the invoices, nor are any numbers shown after No. 9. It is probable that records for Nos. 10 and 11 were missing. The remaining consignments are in correct order as shown on the accounts, and probably the last consignment of Eagles should have been numbered 22. (See Note 141.)

(95) Unfortunately the official documents giving details of the sales at Merida have not so far been found, with the exception of those for the month of October, 1865. In this month consignments were sent to Izamal, Sisal, Valladolid, Tekax, Maxcanú and Motul, but no invoice numbers are shown.

It seems very probable that Merida did not show the numbers on the stamps before 1864, and then printed the year as well, sometimes

before and sometimes after the invoice number, as indicated above. The sales at branch offices were very small.

(96) Consignment 16, December 5th, was sent under No. 18, December 22nd, to Uriangato, and this place returned the whole of the stamps to Morelia, March, 1866.

(97) This is known with two numbers, 20 and 21, 2R on entire letter (C). Scott also records 21, 2R Zamora, but as no 2R were sent with invoice 21, probably this stamp was also similarly corrected.

(98) Consignment No. 29 was stolen in transit.

(99) Although these numbers actually look like 11 (usually impressed 11) and 14, they are almost certainly 41 and 44, as shown.

(100) The official records do not show the number of consignment against each place, but the date order is as shown above, and it is practically certain the invoice numbers were as shown in brackets.

(101) Postmarked in Mexico.

(102) May be found on 115-1868. See Note 38.

(103) Has an additional figure 8. In the district of Querétaro it was the custom for several of the small offices to report to branch offices in their vicinity instead of to the principal. Thus—

Chamacuero reported to Celaya.

Dolores Hidalgo, San Felipe and San Luis de la Paz reported to S. Miguel Allende.

Cadereyta Amealco and Tequisquiapan reported to S. Juan del Río.

The branch offices issued numbered invoices when sending supplies to their subordinates, and it is probable this second number was impressed to correspond. Up to now it has not been possible to say with certainty where invoice 34 was sent, as although details of 21 consignments in 1864 have been obtained from the accounts, the invoice numbers were, unfortunately, not inserted against the entries.

(104) May be found with Querétaro omitted, 2R (C).

(105) Has an additional figure 2. See Note 103.

(106) May be found with additional sub-consignment No. 1, 1R (G).

(107) May be found postmarked Celaya, 2R (C).

(108) May be found postmarked Celaya, 1R (W).

(109) A pair, one with 75 and one with 76 (C).

(110) May be found with sub-consignment 30 in error, 1R and 2R (C).

(111) The cancellation appears to be Puebla both on the 1R and 2R (two of each). This is confirmed by specimens (2R) in collection of Mr. T. W. Hall.

(112) May be found with S. L. Potosi omitted, 2R (C).

(113) Don José Marcó del Pont records sub-consignment No. 155, and in a footnote questions its accuracy. In all probability it is the abbreviated date '865. There is another, almost certainly with sub-consignment 4, dated June and abbreviated date '866. 2R (C).

(114) Also 11 without date, used from Tescaltitlan on 47-1865, 1R (C).

(115) Tula appears to have adopted a separate series of numbers for each branch office. Numbers are not shown for IXMIQUILPAN in 1865 or 1866, but the invoices were issued in the order given above. The Zimapan numbers appear to continue from 1865 into 1866 (the number is not shown for the last one), and assuming the same system in the case of IXMIQUILPAM the numbers would be as indicated above. The cancellations on these stamps are so heavy and indistinct it is impossible to verify the numbers. Mr. Frenzel records sub-consignment No. 10, 4R on 178-1864.

(116) The name Aguascaltes (or, later, in full Aguascalientes) is always overprinted on the stamps. The names of other districts are not.

(117) Commencing with 1865, the date as well as the sub-consignment number is always shown. It is possible the origin of this was the using of stamps dated 1864 for supplies to branch offices in 1865, and that the practice was kept up even when stamps of the current year were in use for all values.

(118) May also be found 11-1854; error in setting type, 1R (C).

(119) The Municipality of S. Juan del Mezquital is situated in the division of Nieves.

(120) May be found with date 186 only, 1R (C).

(121) The Municipality of S. Miguel del Mezquital is situated in the division of Nieves. The cancellation (of which part only shows on the stamp) is quite different from that of S. Juan (119).

(122) These stamps were issued in exchange for those of previous issue returned from private purchasers, and probably consignments of Eagles shown as sent to private individuals may be similarly explained.

(123) May also be found with No. 83 in error (C).

(124) These were sent to replace 140 stuck together when received, which were returned to Mexico, August 22nd (part of invoice 16).

(125) May also be found with Veracruz. Probably error for 85, 25C (C).

(126) May also be found with 34, in error (C).

(127) May also be found with 99 in error (C).

(128) Judging from numbers of stamps invoiced, it would appear that the first engraved stamps issued were the 13c, with invoice 99; the 25c, with invoice 109; the 50c, with invoice 111; and the 7c, with invoice 140. Except for the consignment of 25c to Merida, with invoice 110, it is extremely improbable any lithographed stamps were issued after the invoices given above for the respective values.

(129) This invoice is so entered in the general account. Presumably the stamps were sent to Otumba and debited to Apam.

(130) From this invoice the date is abbreviated to 866.

(131) May be found with date reading 896 (C).

(132) These stamps were stolen in transit and were replaced by invoice 137, with similar numbers of each value.

(133) May also be found with date reading 668 (C) and 86 (C).

(134) This consignment was sent direct to Aguascalientes and debited to Zacatecas. In consequence of Aguascalientes being occupied by the insurgents, the stamps were sent to Zacatecas and received there December 29th.

(135) May also be found with 132 error (C).

(136) May also be found with date reading 668, 13c, and 25c (C).

(137) The following differences from Collin & Calman may be noted:—

- 10 Presumably the stamp seen was post-marked Mexico.
 - 23 Presumably the stamp seen was post-marked Mexico.
 - 24 Presumably overprint indistinct and wrongly read.
 - 37 Same remark as 23.
 - 44 No doubt should have been 41.
 - 56 This is evidently an error in catalogue. Number may have been 68. ? Figures reversed.
 - 63 Is Cuernavaca.
 - 71 No doubt should have been 74.
 - 73 Is Colima. A sheet may have been sent S. L. Potosí in error, as both invoices were despatched same day.
 - 83 Is Guanajuato. Probably the Cuernavaca was 88, badly impressed.
 - 89 Probably 59 badly impressed.
 - 91 Is Pachuca. Probably overprint was indistinct.
 - 92 Is Guanajuato. May have been an error in numbering, as Mexico is next invoice.
 - 98 Is Chalco. Probably overprint was indistinct. No stamps were sent to Saltillo.
 - 100 Is Apam Otumba. May have been postmarked Mexico.
 - 101 Mexico is an error in catalogue. Is correctly shown as Veracruz under "engraved."
 - 123 No doubt should be 133.
 - 135 Probably postmarked Mexico.
- (138) It is not likely that Cuernavaca impressed the numbers of the invoices on the stamps. A letter posted in Tasco, October 7th, shows no trace of a sub-consignment number (C).

(139) The last sub-consignment number known for Eagles being 17, it would seem Guadalajara continued with 18 for Maximilians instead of re-commencing with No. 1.

(140) Jalapa appears to have continued the numbering of sub-consignments from the Eagles. As No. 15 has so far not been traced, it is not certain whether it belongs to the Eagles or to the Maximilians.

(141) Lagos continued the numbering of sub-consignments from the Eagles instead of commencing *de novo* with Maximilians. The official records do not show invoice numbers, but the above are given in date order, and no doubt are approximately in numerical order. Nos. 23 (S), 25 (G), 27 (C), 31 (C) and 33 (G) have been proved by used specimens. The records have not, so far, been traced beyond No. 38, November, 1866. Mr. Regelsperger records 25c. 22 on 22-1866, and if this number is correct, it is either a duplication of the last sub-consignment number of Eagles or those numbers should be changed, commencing with 11 instead of 12.

(142) Unfortunately the accounts for Merida have so far not been traced, and no stamps appear to be known from the majority of the invoices.

(143) By some mistake these were sent to and received by Puruandiro.

(144) These were stolen in transit and replaced by invoice 20.

(145) These were stolen in transit and replaced by invoice 23.

(146) Oaxaca appears to have continued the numbering of sub-consignments from the

Eagles. As the last number so far found on Eagles is 28, and the first on Maximilians 33, it is not possible to say, failing official records, which of the numbers 29 to 32 belong to the Eagle period and which to the Maximilian.

(147) It is curious no other numbers appear to be known. The last number so far recorded on Eagles is 6.

(148) This number recorded by Don José Marcó del Pont should probably be 22.

(149) No. 32 may also be found on a stamp with principal number and date omitted, 1R (C). Probably should have been 103, 1866. 103 sometimes only shows as 03, 25c. (G).

(150) Mr. E. Schmeckpeper has a 25c. overprinted Toluca and Sultepec.

(151) This is no doubt 1867, but is recorded in Collin & Calman as above.

(152) Zacatecas continued the numbering of sub-consignments from the Eagles.

(153) Aguascalientes overprinted in full. Zacatecas not overprinted. Probably sub-consignments 56, 69, and 75 were similar. Mr. Wilson, however, records 75 as "Zacatecas used in Aguascalientes."

(154) Don José Marcó del Pont shows this as No. 96, but if so overprinted it was probably an error for 69, as now shown.

(155) The sub-consignment number on this stamp is 35, but as this number was used for Tepeaca, and issued *before* consignment No. 108 had reached Puebla, it is evident that in this case it is an error—figures reversed.

CIRCULAR NUM. 13

Demostrando la experiencia la necesidad que hay de que subsista una disposicion eficaz que ponga coto á los abusos á que da lugar la circulacion de sellos del previo franqueo, cuando son interceptados ó estraidos de las oficinas con violencia por fuerza mayor; para prevenir los males que por estos hechos, ú otros análogos resultan, se dispone por punto general: que en lo sucesivo y previo el envío que se haga de esta Administracion general á las principales del ramo del surtido que pidan ó se les remita para su despacho y el de sus subalternas, los sellos para el franqueo de la correspondencia pública, deberán contener otro negro marcado que determine en cada uno de ellos el número progresivo de la factura con que son remitidos y el año en que esto tiene lugar, á semejanza de la contramarca que contienen para su validez cuando entran en circulacion, y la que por ningun motivo deberá omitirse.

De igual manera obrarán las mismas oficinas al proveer á sus subalternas del surtido de que necesiten, con la diferencia de que el sello negro de que deben usar, solo contendrá el número correlativo, y no particular, que le corresponde á la factura de envío que hagan de dichos efectos á cada una de sus subalternas, con cuyo objeto deberá tener únicamente una numeracion doble del uno al cero en piezas sueltas, para que por medio de un tornillo sean sujetos en el cajetin los números con que se pretenda hacer la impresion del que corresponda, que será como se ha dicho, equivalente al de la factura de envío. En las poblaciones en que no haya grabador ó que se dificulte la construccion del sello de que se trata, los administradores principales situarán previamente en esta general los cuatro pesos de su importe, para que le sea remitido á cada uno el que le corresponde.

En tal inteligencia, y para el evento de que el robo ó pérdida de sellos, proceda de los que despacha directamente esta Administracion general á cualquiera de las principales; en este caso, cerciorado del hecho esta Administracion, procederá incontinenti y por el inmediato correo á ponerlo en conocimiento de las mismas oficinas por medio de una circular, que trasmitirán en el acto á sus subalternas, para que estando sobre aviso de lo ocurrido no se dejen sorprender y se abstengan de admitir esta clase de sellos, que por el mismo hecho de haber sido eliminados del núcleo legal de su procedencia, carecen de todo valor, siendo por consiguiente nulos para el objeto á que eran destinados.

De la misma manera obrarán los administradores principales respecto de sus subalternas, y con preferencia de esta general, á la vez en que el robo ó extravío de sellos, se verifique al ser remitidos á cualquiera de las oficinas de su dependencia para su despacho; en cuyo caso, el aviso en que lo participen, deberá contener ademas una razon precisa de los dos números de las facturas marcadas en los sellos; esto es, el que se les puso al ser remitidos de esta general, y el que cada uno contenia de la principal que los envió, para consignarlos tambien á las demas principales en igual circular que se les espedirá para sus efectos cada vez que asi acontezca, á semejanza de lo que debe practicarse en el primer caso propuesto.

En cualquier evento en que los sellos robados aparezcan en circulacion, los administradores todos del ramo están en la obligacion de proceder, bajo su mas estrecha respon-

subilidad, conforme se dispone en el artículo 16 del Reglamento de 15 de Julio de 1856, comunicando desde luego el hecho á esta Administracion general, asi como el resultado de la averiguacion judicial que se practique con este motivo.


Como las Administraciones de Correos son los únicos depósitos que existen legalmente para el espendio de los sellos, en lo sucesivo y siempre que acontezca algun robo ó estraccion de los mismos al ser conducidos á su destino, cada oficina dará aviso al público de lo ocurrido, para que estando al corriente de la invalidez de los sellos robados, no se deje sorprender el que los adquiriera sin ser reconocidos, haciéndose cómplice del delito que importan hechos semejantes.

Esto mismo se practicará cuando el robo o estraccion se verifique directamente de alguna oficina del ramo, á cuyo fin y como medida de precaucion, los Administradores principales cuidarán de no contramarcas toda la existencia de sellos que posean, sino únicamente aquella de que necesiten para su despacho diario, y á su vez, la que tengan que remitir para proveer á sus subalternas; mas como puede suceder que algun particular posea legalmente sellos iguales á los robados, porque los haya comprado de los que tenia requisitados para su despacho la oficina de donde fueron extraidos, para evitar el cambio de sellos que por la consumacion de este hecho seria necesario hacer, y una vez presentado el tenedor de ellos por virtud del aviso respectivo, el Administrador responsable, cerciorado de su legal procedencia por los datos que debe tener, segun la prescripcion que contiene el primer párrafo de la circular núm. 10 de este año, procederá á repetir en el centro de cada uno de ellos la contramarca que los autoriza, con cuyo requisito, que solo podrá reiterar la oficina de quien emanaron y previo aviso de lo ocurrido á esta Administracion general, podrán ser válidos para su objeto, entrando por lo mismo en circulacion.

Este nuevo procedimiento tendrá efecto en su totalidad por parte de las Administraciones principales, tan luego como estén provistas del sello de que se trata, lo que efectuado así, cuidarán de comunicarlo con la oportunidad debida á esta Administracion general para que al tanto de ello se pueda obrar en consonancia con las oficinas que los posean, en los casos que ocurran y están previstos en la presente circular de que acompaño á V.







